**Complex Interventions in Healthcare: Focus on Palliative Care**

This session will explore the development, implementation, and evaluation of complex interventions in healthcare, with a specific example from palliative care. Participants will gain insights into assessing the feasibility and acceptability of interventions, essential factors for their successful application in clinical practice. The session aims to provide a practical perspective on improving patient and family outcomes through tailored and effective care strategies.

*Presenter: Assoc. Prof. Gianluca Catania, PhD (University of Genoa, Italy)*

Dr. Gianluca Catania is an associate professor at the University of Genoa, Italy, specializing in oncology and palliative care nursing. He holds a PhD focused on complex nursing interventions aimed at improving the quality of life for advanced cancer patients. With extensive academic and clinical experience, Dr. Catania has served as principal investigator on several funded research projects, including the development of nurse-led interventions and the RN4CAST-Ped study on nursing-sensitive outcomes in paediatric care. He has authored over 90 publications in international journals.

**JBI approach in Evidence Implementation into Practice: How to start doing what is known to work**

She has worked in communication, research and methodology, both in healthcare and education. She participated in development of the first national clinical practice guidelines in the Czech Republic. Dr. Vrbova focuses on implementation of the best available evidence into practice, guided by the methodology of JBI. Tereza lectured in several international implementation training programmes and collaborated in implementation projects.
